Entry Fee \$5 per class/ unless otherwise stated

All exhibitors must be a financial member of the Mannum Ag Society

The minimum status requirement for entry is beef only, unless cattle are from a BJD free or protected zone. Exhibitors must include their accreditation certificate number on the entry form.

Beef only exhibitors must complete the herd health status declaration and return with entry forms.

All Cattle exhibits must have NUS tags NO EXCEPTIONS

- Show Society inspectors reserve the right to ban any animals from judging ring if in their opinion the showing of that animal is likely to detract from the spectacle of the show ring.
- Cattle must be a minimum of Body Score 3 condition on show day
- Late entries will not be accepted
- All fees must accompany entry form otherwise entries will be returned
- All entrants to be named and stud identification stated on entry form - cattle entry form available on our website
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that cattle are entered and show in the correct class
- All cattle are to be registered in the respective societies herd book, including appendix
- Calves entered as calf at foot are not to be entered into any other individual class
- All vehicles to enter via the gate on Belvedere road below footy clubrooms
- Cattle to be on grounds no later than 9.00am on show day
- Maximum age of calves to be eight months old as at 7 March 2026
- Calves must be tattooed and be progeny of the cow entered for competition. Calves must be able to be registered with relevant breed society/association
- Calves must be tethered at all times

NOVELTY

Class 224 Combined Breeders Challenge

- Group of three animals of any one breed
- Not necessarily owned by the exhibitor
- Does not need to include both sexes
- One entry per breed

Class 225 Sires Progeny Group

- To comprise three animals
- Not necessarily owned by the exhibitor
- Name of sire to be stated on the entry form
- Animals are to be drawn from general classes
